SIMON SCHOLARSHIP FUND



High school seniors, it's time to start thinking about applying for the 2011 Simon Scholarship, available to Catholic students in financial need who want to attend an accredited college or university. Scholarships are \$1000 per semester, paid directly to the institution or student upon presentation of receipts paid for tuition, fees and/or room and board. To be eligible, the student must be a registered Catholic in the diocese, must complete the scholarship application and must obtain a written letter of recommendation from a school official (teacher, counselor, principal, coach) and from either their current pastor or a past parish priest. Applications are available in the parish office. Completed applications should be sent to: Simon Scholarship, PO Box 104900, Jefferson City, MO 65110-4900, or faxed to 573-635-0386. Applications must be postmarked or returned to the Chancery by March 31, 2011. All applicants will be notified of the results by May 1, 2011.
