CANDLEMAS February 2 is the feast of the Presentation of the Christ Child in the temple, a light to the nations, which occurs 40 days after Christmas. At the 8:30 Mass it is traditional to bless candles for use in church throughout the year. If you would also like to have your candles blessed for your home use, you may place them with the church candles before Mass.

ST. BLAISE February 3 is the feast of St. Blaise, bishop and martyr. Traditionally, throats are blessed on this Feast. We will bless throats at the 8:30 Mass on Thursday, February 3, and also after the weekend Masses on February 5 and 6.

FIRST FRIDAY will occur on February 4 and will include the anointing of the sick AT THE 8:30 a.m. Mass.

RITE OF CATECHUMENS At the 9:00 a.m. Mass on Sunday, February 6, we will formally welcome those studying to join the church, catechumens, those not baptized and candidates for full communion, those already baptized in another Christian church.

SOUND SYSTEM/HEARING ASSISTANCE

- We've made some improvements to our system. The amplifier and speakers are still good, but had not been properly tuned/calibrated. We added and upgraded some microphones and a new mixer. We also added hearing assistance. As you enter the church there are some small receiver units with an earpiece with their own volume control. Take one as you enter and return after Mass so it can be recharged and reused.
