### IRA Rollover Effective Way to Give in 2011

Congress extended the legislation that allows tax-free distributions to charities through individual retirement accounts (IRA). This is a win/win for donors and the many ministries operating within the Catholic Diocese of Jefferson City.

Prior to the passage of this legislation, distributions from rational IRAs were taxed as income. Extension of this law allows tax-free distributions of up to \$100,000 per year to tax exempt organizations. The IRA rollover serves as a rewarding way to create a legacy that sustains the mission of the church.

#### Requirements:

- Donor must be 70 ½ years old or older.
- No charitable income-tax deduction; distribution is tax-free.
- Qualifies as a minimum distribution from your IRA.
- Can give up to \$100,000 in each year; all gifts must be made by Dec. 31, 2011
- Gifts must be made directly from IRA trustee to charity.
- Applies to traditional and Roth IRAs.

### STOCKS AND BONDS Another Way to Give in 2011

If you have a short term profit in a stock, you pay the ordinary income tax rate on it; whereas, if you *gift* the stock you receive the benefit of the full value of the stock as a donation. For most folks, you have to earn \$1,300 to give \$1,000. Yet in stocks you may have invested less than \$1,000 to give \$1,000.
