### PASTOR'S PEN

Could you not Pray with me for one hour? I invite, encourage, people to attend and pray the entire Mass. It begins, generally on time, with the opening song and concludes with the final blessing - dismissal - Go in peace to love and service the Lord. We begin Mass with the Preparation Rites - Penitential Rite - to dispose us to receive Christ as the readings are proclaimed and anticipating receiving Jesus' Body and Blood in Holy Communion. Together we as the Church, the People of God, should pray the entire Mass together. Unfortunately there is a regular trend here of arriving late and leaving early - entering during the Readings or Homily and leaving at Communion. Not just weekend Masses, but daily Mass as well. I understand folks occasionally arriving late because of car or weather problems or coming from work. Occasionally visitors are unsure of Mass times and directions, arrive late and we need to welcome them. Liturgical Ministers all need to arrive 15 minutes early, so we indeed know who will be leading, reading and serving at the Altar and Ministers of Hospitality to get any instructions and to pray together.

**STEWARDSHIP** - In today's first reading Peter tells his listeners that if they want to follow Jesus they must go against the world, to become what Christian stewards would consider "countercultural." For stewards, being countercultural can consist of surprisingly small decisions - small acts of reorientation to remind them daily that in spite of their life situation, their citizenship, financial status, or color of their skin, they belong, through their baptism, to a new world order in Jesus Christ. Stewards understand that their daily choices should witness to his gospel, not to the trends, attitudes or spending practices of their culture. Stewardship requires us to ask of our daily habits: "In the light of the Gospel, is this important?"

**VOCATIONS** - Next week we will have "Called by Name" in our parish. Please continue to pray for the people you believe the Lord is calling to priesthood, diaconate and/or religious life. Next week, when you come to church, make sure you have the name, age, parents' name (if person is still in school) and address of the people you want to have "called by name."
