PARISH FINANCE COUNCIL

Church Canon Law 537 - In each parish there is to be a finance council which is governed, in addition to universal law, by norms issued by the diocesan bishop and in which the Christian faithful, selected according to these norms, are to assist the pastor in the administration of the *goods* of the parish.

Membership: The Parish Finance Council is about the life of a community of faith and, as such, its members should be members of that community of faith. As in other matters, the Pastor may use his discretion in the selection of qualified members from the parish community.

Purpose:

- Offer technical skills in fiscal matters to the Pastor.
- Assist & advise the Pastor with respect to the supervision of all materials goods belonging to the parish.
- Assist & advise the Pastor concerning the administration of the parish goods.
- Meet no less than 4 times a year.
- Assist the pastor in preparing each year a budget of income and expenditures. This yearly budget of income and expenses will be reviewed by the PPC; then reviewed and approved by the Pastor prior to the beginning of each fiscal year.
- Review the various parish income and expense reports for the total parish no less than twice a year.
- Assist the Pastor in preparing the annual financial report for dissemination to the parish-at-large.
- Assist Pastor in assuring the following are performed:
 - * Timely payment of debt; Timely payment of vendor invoices; Timely payment of interest payments; Investment of surplus funds; Assure adequate revenue thru various means such as tithing programs, fundraisers, planned giving, etc.
- The PFC advises on the adequacy of resources to accomplish the mission and specific ministries of the parish

ADMINISTRATION COMMISSION

The Good News of the Gospel cannot be preached to God's people without some consideration of material needs such as finance, membership, physical plant, personnel resources and future needs of the parish.

Purpose: The basic purpose of the Administration Commission is to share responsibility for the functional aspects of the administration of the parish, building & facilities, stewardship, development & long range planning. They share responsibility with Finance Council.

Membership: The Administration Commission should include, if possible, an accountant or bookkeeper, an attorney, an insurance man, someone with professional knowledge of plant maintenance, and possibly someone with experience in planning. Where they are available and willing to serve, they should be utilized; where they are not, a combination of interest, willingness to work, and intelligent grasp of problems may often compensate for any lack of skills.
