PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL

A unique, collaborative, advisory body called to share with the pastor in determining all important matters that affect the *spiritual* life of the community of faith. A pastoral council possesses a consultative vote only and is governed by the norms established by the diocesan bishop.

Visioning: The role of the council is that of a *visioning* body. It watches the big picture and takes responsibility for pastoral planning and goal setting.

Purpose:

- Council is a *monitoring* body who sees that the goals are being implemented and that there is one vision for the parish—one vision that permeates all parish ministries.
- The council usually divides this monitoring activity and appoints commissions to report regularly on how matters in this area are working.
- Thus, the council plans and sets policy and the staff and commissions are responsible for implementing them and reporting regularly to the council on how this is working.
- Council ô What (vision, policy)
- Staff and Commissions ô How, When, Where, etc. (Implementation)
- The PPC is not meant to be a democratic body nor a business organization—it is called to be a discerning body.
- A group of faith-filled people learning to discover the practical good for the parish through the gift of dialogue.
- Note: Is broadly representative of the community of faith.
- Members should be clearly focused on the *mission of the faith community*—or at least open to a formation that would create that commitment.
- Challenged to become a community of faith.
