The first step to protecting children from sexual abuse is educating parents about the nature of the problem.

Please plan to join us for a Protecting God's Children Workshop for Parents

Developed by National Catholic Services, "Protecting God's Children" is a comprehensive two-and-one-half-hour program that includes two video presentations which incorporate stories from victims of sexual abuse and their families, who speak about the impact that the abuse has had on them.

In addition, the videos feature testimony from perpetrators of child abuse, who tell how they selected their victims and how they made the victims feel that the abuse was their own fault.

The program also provides information on how to prevent situations that can lead to abuse, on what behaviors should raise concern about abuse, and on how to report abuse. We are committed to provide safety for our children.

The workshops will be held on two consecutive Sundays during PSR class time in the church basement:

- Part 1: Sunday, September 25 from 10:15-11:30 a.m.**
- Part 2: Sunday, October 2 from 10:15-11:30 a.m.**

INTERESTED IN LEARNING THE CATHOLIC FAITH?

The Rite of Christian Initiation (RCIA) is a process of faith development and growing in your relationship with God. Adults and children over the age of seven come together on a weekly basis.
